Dan Fogelberg, native son of Peoria, Illinois, touched generations with his inspiring lyrics, sensitive music and smooth vocals. His death at the age of 56 from prostate cancer stunned his legions of fans from around the world. Many have stated Dan wrote the soundtrack of their lives. Despite his passing, his musical legacy continues to shine brightly. One of the purposes of the Fogelberg Foundation of Peoria is to continue to celebrate and honor the artistry and legacy of this extraordinary artist.
